### Merlot

Merlot grapes ripen fairly early and tend to be less dry with higher sugar levels. Merlot produces wines that are generally softer and with slightly higher alcohol content. Merlots are medium to dark red in color, rich, and fruity. Merlot wines tend to be rounder and more supple than Cabernet Sauvignons

### Zinfandel

Zinfandel grape is considered California's red-wine grape because it is not grown in other parts of the world. Zinfandel can produce wines ranging from light, nouveau styles to hearty, robust reds with berrylike, spicy (sometimes peppery) flavors, plenty of tannins and alcohol, and enough depth, complexity, and longevity.

### Syrah / Shiraz / Grenache

Syrah wines are deep-colored and very dry with strong tar, spice and pepper qualities. As they slowly mature, they take on fruity characteristics with a hint of smokiness. Shiraz, Australia's version of Syrah is incredibly rich and complex. Grenache wines are sweet, fruity, and very low in tannin.

### Vino Nobile di Montepulciano

These wines are made from a minimum of 70% Prugnolo(Sangiovese), 10 to 20 percent Canaiolo, and up to 20 percent of other varieties. The wines of this DOCG must be aged for 2 years, 3 years for riserva wines. This DOCG is located in the hilly area around the town of Montepulciano, southeast of Siena in the eastern portion of Tuscany

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### Vino da Tavola - Super Tuscan - Toscana IGT

Italian for table wine, Vino da Tavola, is the humblest class of Italian wine. These superlative wines had to be labeled Vino da Tavola (table wine), though in some cases they were superior to DOCG and DOC wines and able to command higher prices. But such wines were ineligible for Italy's top classification because they were produced using either unauthorized varieties, an unapproved composition, or unsanctioned methods. What to call these superior wines - "Super Tuscan" fit the bill. Today Italy has granted some of the top Super Tuscans their own DOC status.

### Chianti

Chianti is the most famous region of the well-known wine-producing area that runs through central Italy. Chianti's sturdy, dry red wines are made from four grape varieties- Sangiovese, Canaiolo, Trebbiano, and Malvasia and can range from darker, tannic wines to softer and fruitier ones. Chianti Classico is the central zone of this area and its most famous. The wines from this area are identified by a black rooster (gallo nero) on the label, are generally more well known and of better quality. Chianti is a single appellation divided into seven subzones.

### Amarone

Amarone is an Italian wine made in the Veneto region using the Passito method. In this method, grapes are dried in a cool, semidry room for up to four months which produces concentrated sugars and flavors. When fermented until the wine is completely dry, then the term, amarone, which means "stongly bitter", is added to the name.
