Abruzzo- is an Italian wine region on the east (Adriatic) coast. Winemaking traditions in Abruzzo date back to the sixth century BC thanks to the Etruscans, who played a major role in introducing viniculture to the area.

Montepulciano d’Abruzzo - This Italian red is made from **Montepulciano** grapes. It is quite distinct from *Vino Nobile di Montepulciano*, which is a Sangiovese-based wine from Tuscany.

TUSCANY - *The most enduringly famous of all Italian wine regions, thanks to the romantic glamor of its endless rolling hills, cypress-lined country roads and hilltop villages. But even without all of this, evaluated on the merits of its wines alone, Tuscany stands tall, its reputation founded on such iconic wines as Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano*

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano - *One of several classic Tuscan red wines based on the Sangiovese grape variety. It comes from the vineyards that surround Montepulciano, a picturesque hill town in southeastern Tuscany.*

Brunello di Montalcino – *This wine is made exclusively from Sangiovese Grosso grapes grown on the slopes around Montalcino – a classic Tuscan hilltop village south of Siena. Sangiovese Grosso is the large-berried form of Sangiovese. Its name here translates roughly as 'little dark one'. The first recordings of red wines from Montalcino date back to the early 14th Century. However, the all-Sangiovese Brunello di Montalcino style we know today did not emerge until the 1870s, just after the creation of a single Italian state.*

Amarone della Valpolicella - In order to concentrate the natural sugars and aromatics in Valpolicella wines, local producers began drying their grapes after harvest, to remove water from the berries while retaining sweetness and flavor. The early amarone wines were seen as mistakes – recioto left to ferment for too long – but eventually the style gained recognition and great respect.
